1010* David

On his deathbed the prophet Nathan worked with his Wife to arrange for Solomon to be crowned king

970 Solomon

- Never a man with more wisdom and discernment
- allowed his 700 wives and 300 concubines to lead Him into evil idol worship and was told the kingdom would Be divided under his son's reign
- Jereboam was put in charge of the house of Joseph
- Ahijah tore Jereboam's garment into 12 pieces and prophesied that the Kingdom would be divided and 10 of the tribes would go with Jeroboam

930 Rehoboam

- 41 yrs old
- 17 yr reign
- mother was Naamah, an Ammonitess
- Jereboam came and requested taxes to be lowered
- Rehoboam ignored the wise counsel of his father's advisors And sought advice from his peers who said to raise taxes
- Jereboam led a revolt and took 10 tribes with him in the North
- Israel became a separate kingdom

Judah

930 Rehoboam

- in 5th year, Shishak, King of Egypt attacked Jerusalem
- Prophet Shemaiah told him to not war Against Israel
- Warred against Jereboam all his days

913 Abijah, son of Rehoboam 18th yr Jeroboam

- Mother was Mascah, daughter of Abishalom

911 Asa, son of Nebat 20th yr Jeroboam

- grandmother was Maacah, Daughter of Abishalom
- 41 yr reign

Israel

Jereboam, son of Nebat an Ephrathite of Zereda, Solomon's servant, whose mother's name [was] Zeruah, a widow woman

- Reigned 22 years
- Set up altars at Shechem
- instituted "holy day" on 15th day of 8th month with sacrifices To the calves he had made
- Ahijah prophesied that his son would die and be the only family member buried; the rest would die horribly and be eaten in the streets

909	<u>2nd yr Asa</u>	Nadab , son of Jeroboam -2 yr reign
910	<u>3rd yr Asa</u>	Baasha , son of Ahijah -plotted against Nadab and murdered him at Gibbethon a Philistine town -killed Jeroboam's whole family as prophesied by Ahijah -reigned 24 years -received prophecy that his family would die and dogs would eat them in the streets
886	<u>26th yr Asa</u>	Elah , son of Baasha -Reigned in Tirzah 2 yrs
885	<u>27th yr Asa</u>	Zimri , official of Elah who plotted and killed him -killed Baasha and his entire family -reigned 7 days
885		-When Israelites in the camp heard what he'd done they declared Omri, commander of the Army, King -left and laid siege to Tirzah -Zimri went into the royal palace and burned it down around himself
		<u>Israel divided into two factions</u> Omri Tibni, son of Ginath
881	<u>31st yr Asa</u>	Omri officially took throne -defeated Tibni -12 yr (total) reign -bought hill of Samaria from Shomer and built Samaria

874

38th yr Asa

Ahab, son of Omri

-22 yr reign

-married Jezebel, daughter of Eth baal, king of the Sedonians

-Heil of Bethel rebuilt Jericho: he laid the foundation at the cost of his firstborn son Abiram and set up the gate at the cost of his youngest son Segub, according to the Prophecy of Joshua, Son of Nun

-Obadiah in charge of the palace, was devout believer, hid 100 prophets in 2 caves

-Ben-Hadad, King of Aram, along with 30 kings besieged And attacked Samaria; prophet Brought message of victory so Ahab went out at noon while Arameans were getting drunk and defeated them; Ben-Hadad escaped; decided they won because they fought in the hills; the next spring they attacked again in the plains and were defeated again—returned the cities taken by his father; Ahab set him free

-Prophet pronounced death for his family

-Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal

-Ahab wanted Naboth's vineyard in Jezreel (near Megiddo); Jezebel arranged Naboth's death and stole the vineyard

-Elijah prophesied destruction and Jezebel being eaten by dogs in the street

-Never a man as evil as Ahab

870 Jehoshaphat, son of Asa

-35 yrs old

-25 yr reign

-mother was Azuba,

-daughter of Shilhi

4th yr Ahab

-In 3rd year of Jehoshaphat
(after 3 yrs of peace) Ahab and
Jehoshaphat united in battle
against Ramoth Gilead
-Micaiah prophesied defeat and
Ahab died

- 853** 17th yr Jehoshaphat **Ahaziah**, son of Ahab
-2 yr reign
-tried to unite with Jehoshaphat
who said no
- 852** 18th yr Jehoshaphat **Joram**, son of Ahab
-reigned 12 yrs
-fought Moab with Jehoshaphat
And King of Edom
-Elisha prophesied victory
-Arameans besieged Samaria
-Naaman, servant to king of
Aram, healed of leprosy
through Elisha
- 847** **Jehoram**, son of Jehoshaphat 5th yr Joram
-32 yrs old
-reigned 8 yrs
-Edom rebelled
-Libnah rebelled at same time
- 840** **Ahaziah**, son of Jehoram 12th yr Joram
839 -1 yr reign
-Mother was **Athaliah**,
Granddaughter of Omri,
King of Israel
-Killed by Jehu, King of Israel
- 839** **Athaliah** killed the entire royal family after
Ahaziah's death
-Ahaziah's son Joash was hidden away
-ruled 6 yrs
-in 7th yr, Jehoida the priest arranged
& anointed Joash
- 834** **Joash**, son of Ahazia 7th yr Jehu
-7 yrs old
-reigned 40 yrs
- Jehu**, son of (different) Jehoshaphat
-Killed Joram
-Anointed while commander
-Killed Ahab, his entire family,
Jezebel and Ahazia (King of
Judah)

812	-Ahazael, King of Aram, Attacked Jerusalem—pd off with Temple gold -murdered by his officials	<u>23rd yr Joash</u>	Jehoahaz , King of israel -reigned 17 yrs -King of Aram opposed Israel so Jehoaz sought the Lord who had mercy
795		<u>37th yr Joash</u>	Jehoash , son of Jehoahaz -reigned 16 yrs
794	Amaziah , son of Joash -25 yrs old -reigned 29 yrs	<u>2nd yr Jehoash</u>	-warred against Amaziah
793		<u>15th yr of Amaziah</u>	Jereboam , son of Jehoash -Reigned 41 years -Expanded Israel -Servant was Jonah, son of Amitar, prophet from Gath Hepher
792	Azariah , son of Amaziah -16 years old -also called Uzziah	<u>27th yr of Jeroboam</u>	
771		<u>38th yr of Azariah</u>	Zechariah , son of Jereboam -6 month reign -4 th gen of Jehu (as prophecied) -Shallum son of Jabesh murdered
770		<u>39th yr of Uzziah</u>	Shallum -1 month reign -killed by Menahem
770		<u>39th yr of Azariah</u>	Menahem , son of Gadi -invaded by Pu, king of Assyria
759		<u>50th yr Azariah</u>	Pekahiah , son of Menahem -killed by Peka

- 757** 52nd yr Azariah **Pekah**, son of Remaliah
-Resin, King of Arameans
Helped besiege Ahaz
-reigned 20 yrs
- 756** **Jotham**, son of Uzziah (Azariah) 2nd yr Pekah
-25 yrs old
-16 yr reign
-mother was Jerusha,
Daughter of Zadok
- 740** **Ahaz**, son of Jotham 17th yr Pekah
-16 yr reign
- 728** 12th yr Ahaz **Hoshea**, son of Elah
-killed Pekah and took throne
- 726** **Hezekiah**, son of Ahaz 3rd yr Hoshea
-25 yrs old
-reigned 29 years
-mother was Abijah,
Daughter of Zechariah
- 720** 4th yr Hezekiah/
7th yr Hoshea
6th yr Hezekiah/
9th yr Hoshea
-Shalmaneser (from Assyria)
laid siege to Israel for 3 yrs
- Assyria captured Samaria
- Assyria brought people from
Babylon to settle Samaria
- Sennachareb (from Assyria) 14th yr Hezekiah
Attacked Judah
-paid off w/ Temple gold
-Threatened Jerusalem anyway
-Hezekiah sought Isaiah &
Cleansed Judah
-Angel of the Lord defeated
Sennachareb who retreated to
Ninevah
-Babylonian envoy visits & gets tour
- 697** **Manasseh**, son of Hezekiah
-12 yrs old
-55 yr reign
- 642** **Amon**, son of Manasseh
-22 yrs old
-reigned 2 yrs
-mother was Meshulemeth, daughter

Of Harriz from Jotba
-killed by his officials
-The people killed the guilty officials

640 Josiah, son of Amon

-8 yrs old
-reigned 31 yrs
-Mother was Adidah from Bozkath
-in 18th yr of his reign, Helkiah the priest found the Torah
-Josiah cleansed the land and renewed the covenant
-Passover celebrated
-Killed by Pharaoh Neco at Megiddo

609 Jehoahaz, son of Josiah

-23 yrs old
-carried off to Egypt in chains

608 Eliakam, son of Josiah, made king by Neco

-Neco changed Eliakam's name to Jehoiakam
-25 yrs old
-reigned 11 yrs
-mother was Zebidah, daughter of Pedaiah from Rumiah
-Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon invaded and it was 3 yrs
Before Jehoiakam rebelled

605 Babylon invaded Egypt

598 Jehoiachin, son of Jehoiakam

-18 yrs old
-reigned 3 mos
-Babylon laid siege and took Jehoiachin captive

597 Mattaniah, Jehoiachin's uncle, made king

-name was changed to **Zedekiah**
-21 yrs old
-reigned 11 yrs
-mother was Hamertal, daughter of Jeremiah, from Libnah
-rebelled against Babylon in 9th yr (10th day of 10th month)
-Babylon started 2 yr siege
-by 11th yr (9th day of 4th month) there was no food
-taken in shackles to Babylon

586 Nebuchadnezzar had Temple destroyed by fire
Judah in captivity—poor left to farm land
Gedaliah, son of Ahikam, son of Shaphan, appointed Governor
-promised to do good by people
-killed anyway

In 37th yr of exile of Judah, King Jehoiachin released by new King of Babylon and elevated to place of honor in his court
